



Decorated Vase, Bronze, China, Qing Dynasty, 18th-19th Century.

Description

A bulbous bronze vase with archaic decoration. Two handles in the form of stylised zoomorphic creatures are situated on either side of the neck. The decorative band on the body depicts a distinctive, symmetrical mask of the mythical monster Taotie (characterised by large eyes and horn-like protrusions). The background of the decoration is filled with a dense geometric motif known as Leiwen (a pattern of clouds and thunder, resembling square meanders). In the lower section, pointed-arch panels are filled with geometric patterns. The vase is signed. China, Qing Dynasty, 18th-19th century. Patinated bronze. Height: 35 cm, diameter: 30 cm. Condition: good.
