A boxwood sculpture depicting Christ on the cross, created around 1600-1650. The dying Christ leans his head onto his left shoulder, revealing twisted, openwork hair. In the Mannerist style, his imposing musculature is accompanied by a network of veins spreading across his limbs. The perizonium, held in place by a knot, is rendered as cascades of folds.
