Description

This poetic winter landscape, executed in oil on canvas in the second half of the seventeenth century by a talented artist from the circle of the Dutch master Jacob van Ruisdael (1628-1682), represents a magnificent example of Western European Baroque art. The composition is based on the rare subject of a winter capriccio, masterfully uniting the austere poetry of northern nature with the monumental architecture of an imaginary castle. Upon the snow-covered bank and the smooth surface of the frozen river, the figures of strolling and ice-skating townspeople in authentic historical costumes are captured. The artist skillfully utilizes the color palette and techniques of chiaroscuro, as storm clouds and the walls of the majestic castle are only lightly touched by the golden glow of the sunset.
