This impressive French giltwood mirror, dating to circa 1890, was crafted in the elegant Louis XVI style and features exceptional decorative detailing combined with generous proportions. Measuring over 57 inches high, it was designed as a statement piece, bringing light, depth, and sophistication to an interior. The finely carved frame is adorned with classical Louis XVI motifs, including beaded moldings, ribbon ornaments, floral garlands, and beautifully executed corner embellishments. The richly sculpted crest displays a ribbon-tied floral wreath surrounded by delicate foliage, creating a

refined architectural presence. Retaining its original gilded finish, the frame exhibits a warm, beautifully aged patina acquired over more than a century. Areas of gentle wear reveal traces of the traditional red bole beneath the gilding, a characteristic often associated with quality French craftsmanship of the late nineteenth century. The mirror plate appears original and displays the subtle imperfections, light spotting, and character expected from antique mercury-backed or early silvered glass. The rear retains its original period backing and construction, further supporting the authenticity of the piece. Its elegant proportions make it ideal above a fireplace, console, sideboard, or as a striking decorative feature in a living room, entrance hall, bedroom, or dressing room. A timeless and highly decorative French mirror that beautifully combines Louis XVI elegance with the charm and authenticity of a late nineteenth-century original.
