Description

Pair of corner cabinets resting on a curved quarter-round base made of solid light cherry wood, mid-18th century, in perfect condition. Each cabinet opens with two arched doors, molded and scalloped at the top. The doors feature beautiful ironwork on both the interior and exterior, as well as locks with keys that work perfectly, all entirely period. Pair of corner cabinets topped with their period marble slabs, Caunes-Minervois red marble, molded with a corbin beak and a curved front (3 cm thick). Back and sides in oak and cherry wood. Inside, a fixed shelf in each corner cabinet. Pair of corner cabinets with exquisite cabinetry, typical of the 18th century.
