An interesting oil on canvas mounted on a wooden panel depicting the triumph of Silenus. A beautiful scene of Bacchanalia filled with numerous figures: Silenus appears wearing a wreath of vine leaves, holding a cup, and riding an ox. He is surrounded by Bacchantes and satyrs dancing and playing musical instruments, all set against a bucolic landscape. This oil on canvas is vibrant in color and is also unique due to its oval shape. The figures' features are lightly sketched, as if this were a preparatory study for a larger painting. The canvas is in good condition and has a few small areas of missing paint on the angel at the top of the composition in the sky. The canvas has been mounted on a wooden panel. It is presented in a lovely Napoleon III-style stucco and gilded wood frame decorated with ribbons
