Manufacture d'Augustin: A low-pile rectangular rug made of woven wool with a cotton backing, using the tapestry technique. Featuring a central decoration of a floral wreath and bouquets in the four corners on a mottled brick-and-beige field, within a wide border simulating a frieze of acanthus leaves. Work from the late 18th or early 19th century, c. 1800, Consulate / Empire
