Moroccan rifle known as a Moukhala - Morocco, Rif region, 19th century Rif-region rifle with a wide stock. Barrel made of fine dark wood, likely ebony. Ivory butt plate. Gold-inlaid damascene lock. European octagonal barrel with gold inlay at the breech and muzzle. Barrel secured to the stock by 6 rings of chased and embossed silver. The hammer does not hold cocked. Minor damage to the wood. A chip at the bottom of the ivory butt plate. Length 155 cm Barrel length 120 cm Muzzle diameter 14 mm Weight 3240 g
