### Description

The Child Christ on the Cross, Early 19th-Century Alabaster. The Child Christ in Adoration, contemplating the beginnings of his future. A moving 19th-century alabaster statue depicting the Child Christ in adoration on the Cross. Depictions of the Child Jesus in meditation, alone facing his destiny as he rests on a cross, are rare. He is rarely depicted as a child meditating near a cross in his father's workshop (see the painting by the Le Nain brothers) or pricking himself with a crown of thorns (see the painting by Francisco de Zurbarán). Here we have this moving depiction in a high-quality statue. The Child Jesus is finely rendered; the sculptor has managed to convey in the child's face both the tragedy of his fate and his inner radiance. This work is rare for its iconography! The drapery of
