### Description

Léon Louis Oury (1846-1929) A Cow Drinking Near a Mill (probably near Chartres) oil on canvas, signed and dated 1904 71x92cm important period gilded wood frame 98x121cm Léon Louis Oury, born on December 6, 1846, in Chartres, where he died on June 6, 1929, was a French painter. Léon Louis Oury was the son of Hyppolite Oury (1811-1893), chief secretary at the Chartres City Hall, and Marie Elisabeth Rosalie Eustache (1822-1895). His maternal grandfather was the painter Honoré Jean Dubois-Duperray; his niece, Thérèse Marie Oury-Picavet (1880-1972), would also become a painter. In 1878, he married Joséphine Sophie Edian; Ladislav Ciesielski served as a witness at the wedding. A student of Isidore Pils and Gabriel Ferrier, he exhibited at the Salon beginning in 1880.
