Algerian rifle known as the Moukhala - Algeria, 19th century. Octagonal barrel of European manufacture, marked with the name of the famous 17th-century Italian arquebusier "Lazaro Lazarino". Miquelet lock. The trigger does not hold when cocked. Wooden stock inlaid with bone and decorated with brass nails and blue cabochons that appear to be earthenware. A missing screw head on the hammer. Minor damage to the wood. One blue cabochon is missing. Length 169 cm. Barrel length 128.5 cm. Muzzle diameter 18 mm. Weight approx. 3581 g.
