### Description

Pair of quiver-shaped candlesticks in gilded bronze, Consulate period, 18th century. Fluted shafts in the shape of quivers, topped with a gadrooned ring. They rest on a circular base engraved with a frieze featuring a cord motif. Mercury gilding with a double patina, predominantly original and in good condition (some wear on the shafts, slight variations on the lamp heads). Work from the late 18th-century Consulate period, based on a design by Claude Galle.
