It should be noted that this image is a printed reproduction rather than an original hand-painted panel. The warm gilt finish has developed a pleasing patina over time, complemented by minor wear and imperfections consistent with age and use. The construction, decorative treatment, and materials are characteristic of French production from the turn of the twentieth century.
