Description

Vincent De Vos (1829-1875) Pointing Dog and Game Bird Oil on panel, signed lower right. Animal scene depicting a pointing dog alongside a hunting carnivore in a rural landscape. The subject, particularly decorative, follows the Flemish tradition of animal painting inherited from the 17th and 18th centuries. Vincent De Vos, born in Kortrijk in 1829 and died in the same city in 1875, was a Belgian painter known for his animal depictions and genre scenes. He exhibited regularly at the Triennial Salons of Belgium as well as at the Salons in Paris. His works are now held notably at the Groeninge Museum in Bruges as well as in several public collections across Europe, including in Lille, Tourcoing, Mulhouse, and London.
