A 1919-model kepi, modified in the 1930s by the addition of the bandolium of a chief warrant officer in an administrative branch. Probably a kepi from the Quartermaster Corps, featuring this central grenade embroidered in gold thread and sequins between two crossed olive branches. It could also be attributed to the Medical Corps. Finally, one last possibility would be to attribute it to a clerk of the autonomous corps of the Military Justice Service. Smooth fastening button for the false chinstrap. Red top with fine gold border braid, a gold braid flecked with red, and a simple Hungarian knot characteristic of senior non-commissioned officers. Black leather visor, high-quality gray satin lining, black leather sweatband. Good condition. Size 52/53 cm.- This item is available for immediate purchase, payable
