A very large, framed engraving from the 18th century depicting a festival on the Tiber River in Rome. This work was engraved by Pierre Jacques Duret (1729-1804) after a painting by Claude Joseph Vernet (1714-1789). A highly decorative and interesting engraving due to its size and the quality of its details. Gilded baguette frame. A small tear in the lower left corner and foxing on the paper. Date: late 18th century. Shipping via carrier between two wooden boards: 100 euros within France, 200 euros within the EU, and 600 euros to the rest of the world.
