The shape and style are inspired by the very first French silver cutlery from the second half of the seventeenth century, often described as "rat-tail." There are 3,600 grams of weighable pieces, excluding the knives. 12 dinner forks 12 dinner spoons 12 dinner knives 12 dessert forks 12 dessert spoons 12 dessert knives 12 teaspoons 12 cake forks For a total of 96 pieces each engraved with two intertwined initials in the Mavelot style, likely an L and a G.
