This portrait by Jean Ducayer is a fine example of 17th-century French aristocratic portraiture, combining elegance, rich textiles, and classical restraint. Its intimate format, the quality of the rendering of materials, and the presence of symbols of rank make it a representative work of court painting under Louis XIII. Jean Ducayer was a painter active in Paris between 1605 and 1635, specializing in court portraits and depictions of ladies of high rank.
