Description

"The Water Carrier," a bronze sculpture with a double patina, signed on the Debut terrace and bearing a "Bronze Guaranteed" stamp from Paris. Cartouche: Prix de Rome Didier Debut was a French sculptor born on June 4, 1824, in Moulins and died on April 5, 1893, in the 4th arrondissement of Paris. He exhibited at the Salon starting in 1848 and won the Second Prize of Rome in 1851. He participated in major decorative projects for Parisian monuments in the second half of the 19th century, including City Hall, the Palais Garnier, and the Commercial Court.
