A cylindrical ring decorated with circular, interlaced lines and gadroons. A long stem extends from its center, supporting a small disc on which tobacco was placed before being brought to the nostril. An example of this can be found in F. Neyt's book, "Arts de la Benué," 1985, no. IV.45, p. 200, MRAC, Tervuren. Tiv people, Nigeria. Copper alloy. Height: 12 cm. First third of the 20th century or earlier.
