A pair of miniature bronze frames from the 1850s containing two superb gouaches on ivory depicting two siblings aged approximately 4 to 6 years. The painter, Edmé Rousseau, has admirably captured the personalities of these two children in his painting, as well as the details of their faces and clothing, despite the limited space. Everything is original; the little girl is in slightly poorer condition--she likely suffered from humidity damage in the past, the ivory is cracked, and the glass has a chip at the bottom--while the little boy is in good condition.
