Description

This unique work is part of a series created under the pseudonym "Tagritte," whose artistic universe draws freely from the legacy of Surrealism while developing a deeply personal iconography. The composition depicts the bust of a nude woman set against a seascape of great simplicity. Yet the true subject of the painting lies in the transformation of the model's face. The artist replaces the figure's usual features with a luminous sky filled with clouds. Far from being a mere absence, this celestial space gradually reveals to the viewer a second, immaterial, and almost dreamlike female face, drawn by the vaporous shapes of the clouds. This apparition creates a subtle dialogue between the real body and the idealized image of the woman. The model seems to divide her identity between a perfectly tangible physical

presence and a mental, dreamlike, or spiritual presence. The face becomes a landscape, while the landscape becomes a portrait. The calm sea and the horizon line reinforce the impression of silence and contemplation that emanates from the whole. The work evokes at once memory, dreams, recollection, and the invisible aspect of all human identity. Through its economy of means and the power of its symbolism, this composition transcends a mere surrealist reference to offer a poetic meditation on the duality between appearance and inner life, between reality and the imagination. The contrast between the physicality of the body and the lightness of the clouds gives the work a particularly strong visual presence and a great capacity for evocation.
