Description

A superb example of Charles Dudouyt's Art Deco sculptural style, this oak sideboard, dating from around 1940, perfectly illustrates the designer's characteristic interplay of geometry, artisanal craftsmanship, and rustic modernity. Dudouyt's work is renowned for its bold architectural presence, and this piece captures that spirit with its deeply carved geometric panels, circular accents, and strong, rhythmic composition. Crafted from solid oak, the front features hand-carved linear grilles punctuated by medallions, creating a dynamic relief that plays beautifully with light and shadow. The central section introduces a horizontal linearity, balancing the more sculptural doors on either side. The interior offers generous storage space thanks to its shelves, making the piece as

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functional as it is visually striking. This sideboard has been carefully restored, respecting its original character while bringing out the warmth and depth of the oak grain. The result is a clean, refined surface that highlights the craftsmanship without altering the tactile authenticity of the period. A centerpiece for collectors, interior designers, and lovers of French Art Deco, this piece anchors both contemporary and classic interiors thanks to its sculptural presence and the timeless quality of its materials.
