**Saint Louis: A Crystal Liqueur Or Port Decanter In Cut Purple, Tommy Model.**

Description

- A conical decanter with its original triangular stopper, originally used for liqueur or port, made of cut crystal in a parma purple hue, Tommy model from the Saint-Louis crystal factory located in the Münzthal Valley in the Moselle department (57) in the Lorraine region.- The Saint-Louis factory is the oldest in France and is now part of the Hermès Group.- From the star-shaped base of the decanter to the dazzling reflections of the diamond-cut bevels and pearl fillets, Tommy is timeless.- Since 1928, its elegant lines have graced the most refined table settings.- The parma-colored crystal liqueur decanter bears the Saint-Louis crystalworks stamp beneath its round, star-cut base; the number 27 is diamond-point engraved beneath the stopper.- This liqueur or port decanter in

parma-colored crystal is antique and in good condition; it is possible to detect a few small signs of use. This decanter is handmade, which explains the small differences that can sometimes be found (height, weight, patterns...)-- Far from being flaws, these differences make this liqueur or port decanter a unique piece.- Appreciate them for the true value of the work carried out by the master glassmakers at the Saint-Louis crystal factory.- Note: a slight white streak inside the decanter and a micro-chip under the base of the decanter, as well as on a tip of the diamond-cut around the decanter. See photos.- Date: 20th century, from 1928 to the present.- Reminder to buyers regarding the right of withdrawal for online sales via my Proantic shop.- Must be read before purchasing from my sales site hosted by Proantic.-- The right of withdrawal applies to sales made through my Proantic shop.- The withdrawal period is 14 days following the buyer's receipt of the item or goods.- The buyer must notify me via email or registered letter--without needing to provide a reason or justification--within the 14-day period prescribed by law, starting from the receipt of the parcel or goods.- The buyer has the right to change their mind and is entitled to a 14-day cooling-off period under this withdrawal law, and I respect this right.- Once this period has elapsed, the sale will be considered final and binding.- Return shipping costs (via postal service or carrier) are the buyer's responsibility in the event of withdrawal.- The buyer is required to return the goods or item within 14 days of receipt, in the same condition in which it was received--without breakage or damage--and in the original packaging, using the same shipping method and insurance coverage (matching the sale price on my Proantic shop) as originally arranged by the seller; the buyer must also email me the proof of posting/drop-off receipt issued by the postal service or the shipping slip issued by the carrier. - All sales made via my Proantic site are covered by insurance purchased from La Poste at the time

of shipping; this covers loss or theft up to the purchase price paid by the buyer.- La Poste does not provide insurance against breakage or damage to the item or object; shipping coverage extends only to theft and loss.- Additional insurance covering breakage or damage--up to the price paid by the buyer on my Proantic site--is always purchased from the carrier when a third-party carrier is used.- The buyer faces potential legal penalties if they fail to return the item or object within the 14-day timeframe or if it is not returned in good condition.- Refunds for the item or object will be issued within 14 days of the seller receiving the item or package and verifying the condition of the item or object.- If the item or object is found not to match its original condition at the time of dispatch, the sale will be considered final and non-refundable; the right of withdrawal will not apply.- Refunds for the item or object will be issued using the same payment method (check, bank transfer, PayPal) used by the buyer for the original purchase on my Proantic site.- If payment was made via PayPal, the buyer is responsible for initiating the refund process themselves--specifically by navigating to the "Dispute" section and opening a dispute case involving themselves, PayPal, and the seller. - This note regarding sales on my Proantic page is addressed to individuals who are litigious or acting in bad faith.- I advise such individuals against making any purchases on my Proantic page; this will prevent me from wasting time and money on legal proceedings.- Fortunately, my sales on Proantic generally go very smoothly, as my customers are typically pleasant, agreeable, and acting in good faith.- Sincerely,- Mr. Pineaud.
