Dimensions: Height: 161 cm Width: 85 cm Price: EUR900 This appears to be a "Phrabot," an ancient Thai temple scroll painting. The creation of a Phrabot had profound religious significance, tied to the concept of earning merit, a key element of Buddhism. It could be attributed to the "Rattanakosin" school (1787-1910), executed with matte pigments on fabric or a textured panel. Rattanakosin is the exact term used in Thai historiography to refer to the historical period of the first seven Chakri monarchs, between the founding of Bangkok as the capital of Thailand in
