Stoneware vase by Jean Claude Séris, a ceramic artist born in 1941 and based in Tonneins (47); trained in Ratilly, he is particularly known for designing vases for the art of ikebana. This minimalist vase is designed like a sculpture, a balancing act between solids and voids, a dialogue between the interior and the exterior. It is made of glazed pyrite stoneware, brown on the outside and gray on the inside. A utilitarian and sculptural object. Signed on the base. Work from the 1980s
