The spring is firm but the hammer does not hold cocked. Wooden stock inlaid with bone and silver plates depicting scrolls and flowers. Bone butt plate. Slight damage to the wood. Missing and damaged silver tip on the ramrod. Length 178 cm. Barrel length 137 cm. Muzzle diameter 16 mm. Weight approx. 3800 g.
