### Description

Théodore Lévigne (1848-1912) *Towpath along the river* This delicate oil on canvas by Théodore Lévigne showcases the painter's talent for rural landscapes imbued with calm and poetry. A peasant woman accompanied by goats walks along a path bordering a peaceful river, dominated by an imposing rock that frames the composition. The soft light, the slightly misty distance, and the artist's fluid brushwork lend the scene a serene and harmonious atmosphere. Born in Noirétable in 1848, Théodore Lévigne was one of the most esteemed representatives of the Lyon School. A student at the Beaux-Arts in Lyon and later under Cabanel and Gérôme in Paris, he distinguished himself through his landscapes, genre scenes, and portraits,
