Description

A very pretty oil lamp made of patinated bronze, Viennese bronze, and glass. With its fluid, light design, it embodies the floral art style that was all the rage among artists of this period, such as Majorelle, Mucha, Guimard, Gallé, Daum, Lalique, and others. A true testament to the creative effervescence of the Belle Époque, this table lamp perfectly illustrates the naturalistic and poetic repertoire so dear to the École de Nancy. The slender, fluid silhouette of the Viennese bronze heron, captured amidst a plant motif of undulating curves, lends a unique, ethereal lightness to the piece. The finesse of the engraving and the richness of the antique patina make this antique lamp a refined collector's piece, worthy of a place in a cabinet of curiosities or of adding a touch of timeless elegance to a high-end interior.
