Pair of cloisonné enamel vases with silver wire on copper Japan, Meiji period, late 19th to very early 20th century Work likely associated with the workshop of Namikawa Yasuyuki (1845-1927) or Hayashi Chuzo Decor featuring wading birds pobably Nippon Ibis among irises on a green background Damage and restoration: one at the neck, theother on the lower side without affecting the decoration and a chip on a ridge on the back of one vase Superb quality of workmanship from a major workshop despite the mentioned flaws, which are barely visible 19 cm in height All questions welcome
