A Pair Of Antique Louis XIII-style Oak Armchairs, Upholstered In A Patchwork Of Antique Fabrics

Description

Pair of French oak armchairs in the Louis XIII style, dating from the late 19th to early 20th century. These two armchairs feature a wooden frame typical of the historicist reinterpretations of the era: turned legs connected by an H-shaped crossbar and curved, comfortable armrests. The frame has been restored and reinforced; in particular, small metal brackets have been added under the armrests to ensure perfect stability. The armchairs are upholstered in crazy patchwork, made from antique fabrics, some of which are embroidered. This textile work was specifically designed for these armchairs; it follows the contours of the seat and backrest, creating a unique and harmonious decorative effect, in which every fragment of fabric contributes to a coherent artistic composition. The upholstery

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work--using springs--was carried out by one of Rome's finest artisans in the field. Armchairs of great character, combining historic furniture and handcrafted textile creation, recommended for a setting that blends tradition, color, and contemporary decorative art. Condition: excellent overall condition. The armchairs have been carefully maintained and rarely used.
