The openwork setting, accented with small diamonds and adorned with architectural motifs, is characteristic of the Neo-Gothic style, which experienced a significant revival during the second half of the 19th century. Its slender composition and ogival shapes are reminiscent of certain works by Jules Wiese. Work from the second half of the 19th century. Very good overall condition. The sapphire shows some signs of wear. Slight traces of glue visible on the pearls. Gross weight: 6.55 g.
