The upper panel houses a large drawer constructed with traditional dovetail joints. The back panel is embellished with an original period mirror featuring antique oxidized silver plating. The top is made of shaped black marble. The frame bears a "JACOB" stamp, attributable to the renowned Parisian cabinetmaking tradition of the Jacob family. Condition: good.
