Hunting Dagger of Honor from the School of Forestry, Third Republic, Late 19th Century. Dagger from the Nancy School of Forestry, dating from after 1870--the end of the Second Empire--and before 1898, when the school became the National School of Water and Forests.- Silver-plated crossguard with a double quillon shaped like a wolf's head, featuring the inscription "FORÊTS" in the center, set upon two oak leaf branches. Silver-plated pommel decorated with a fox's head. Horn tang with vertical grooves. Straight blade, 57 cm long, etched on the front with a hunting trophy and foliage wreaths, and on the back with the inscription "Ecole Forestière." Engraved blade back. Dark-grain leather scabbard with two silver-plated metal fittings. Pommel with belt
