Set of four nesting tables featuring marquetry with rich decorative motifs of leaves and flowers, such as reeds, water lilies, and irises. Also featuring small animals and insects such as toads, swallows, magpies, and dragonflies. Signed "J. Guth" within the design. Art Nouveau-era piece. Good condition, with some previous restorations and filled cracks. Highly original marquetry design. Joseph Guth, a brother but nonetheless distinct from Paul Guth, was a manufacturer of high-quality furniture during the Art Nouveau period. He was based in Nancy and worked in a style similar to that of Gallé during the same era.

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
