### Description

Small mortar made from white marble, similar in quality to Carrara marble, - late 18th / 19th century, carved in a soft, organic shape. Body has a rounded profile with thick walls, flaring slightly toward the opening. Upper rim features four rounded protrusions reminiscent of "bear cub ears," one of which is shaped into a small, discreet spout, serving both decorative and functional purposes. This distinctive feature gives it a character that is both naive and elegant. Exterior surface is smooth, weathered by time, while rim shows slight signs of wear, evidence of its age. Inside is hollowed out into a uniform bowl shape. Dimensions: approximately 10 cm per side x 8 cm high. Weight: approx. 1 kg Condition: good antique condition, with signs of wear on edges.
