The "Cansado" bench, designed by Charlotte Perriand, is a true collector's item. Created for the company "MIFERMA," it was used to furnish the apartments of the company's executives. Its decidedly modern design makes it a must-have piece that fits easily into any interior. The frame and legs are made of black-lacquered steel, topped with 13 mahogany slats. The cushions are covered in an anthracite wool fabric by Nobilis. Other fabrics are available upon request. Provenance: Executive housing in the mining town of Cansado, Mauritania, built in the 1960s by the Mauritanian Iron Mining Company "MIFERMA" to house its staff. Some of the furniture was designed by Charlotte Perriand between 1959 and 1967. Seat height: 35 cm
