Description

A two-handled libation cup with silver-plated metal and a dolphin motif, a ritual object from French Freemasonry. The hemispherical body rests on a fluted pedestal. The two dolphin-shaped handles feature chiseled scales and volute-shaped bodies. The body bears the inscription: R? L? Les Arts Réunis Le Réveil Charollais Or? de Mâcon January 24, 5988. Marked with two hallmarks: the maker's mark (a cup with the initials BR) and the fineness mark "89" in a rectangular cartouche. D. 16.2 cm H. 11.9 cm Légères piqures
