19th-century French school, Studies of Horses and a Rider two drawings in the same frame 7 x 11 cm (oval) and 7 x 9.8 cm pencil on paper Condition: The oval drawing on the left has some foxing (see photos) framed under glass, 20 x 40 cm The subject, style, and even the execution of these two drawings clearly recall the works of Édouard Detaille. We know how much this artist loved to draw horses. These are likely not by him, but by an artist from the same period. The late 19th century marked a golden age for academic art depicting soldiers and horses. These two drawings are a very good example of this.
