Description

An elegant and spectacular sculptural floor lamp depicting a stylized heron, an iconic work by French designer René Broissand, produced by Santangelo in the early 1970s. Crafted in polished gilded bronze, the shaft features remarkably fluid lines that subtly evoke the slender silhouette of the wading bird. The minimalist treatment of the subject--reduced to a few taut curves and clean volumes--gives this creation a presence that is both graphic and poetic, characteristic of 1970s French design. The piece offered here is signed "R. Broissand Santangelo" and numbered 57, attesting to its authenticity and its status as part of a limited series. Pieces from this prestigious edition remain highly sought after today by collectors of 20th-century lighting and design furniture. Mounted on a square base made of
