QUIVER and BLOWGUN ARROWS known as Log or Käräban Palawan culture, Philippines
Circa 1900 Bamboo and plant fibres H.: 27; L.: 5.5 cm
Quiver and its blowpipe arrows - some weighted at the base with a small plant cone - used for hunting monkeys and small game. It consists of two cylindrical sections of bamboo - one forming the snap-on lid and the other the body; decorated with an engraved design resembling a mountain. Double bindings of plaited plant fibres, one of which holds a carved wooden hook which, whilst walking, allowed it to be suspended from the belt or loincloth.
