Description

The broad family of Kazakh rugs is divided into about fifteen distinct groups, among which the Fachralo stands out. It is their composition and motifs that set them apart. On this rug, the shape of a mirhab

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can be seen at each end of the central field, indicating that it is a prayer rug. Other hallmarks of antique Kazakh rugs include remarkable wool quality--soft and almost silky--as well as extremely deep and luminous colors. The pile is approximately 1 cm thick for optimal comfort. Two background colors share the central field: madder red and a saturated indigo midnight blue. The borders, featuring intertwined geometric patterns, frame the central field, with each motif evoking a sense of protection. This piece is referenced in the book **Le tapis du Caucase**, published by Office du Livre (see photos). The carpet is in a state of preservation that borders on the miraculous. Exclusively plant-based dyes of infinite purity. A true museum piece! Circa 1920
