Description

This elegant set of four low, double candelabras in solid silver exemplifies the 20th-century taste for geometric forms and the dynamism inherited from the Art Deco aesthetic. Each piece features a sculptural design consisting of a silver ribbon winding spirally around an open circular base, creating an effect of continuous movement and lightness despite the density of the metal. The lampshade, with its flared shape and understated molding, rests on an asymmetrical tray with that contrast with the geometric precision of the spiral structure. The fluid lines of the metal ribbon intersect with precision, evoking both modernist explorations of volume and certain characteristic of the 1930s through the 1950s. The design relies entirely on the interplay of curves and negative space, without any added ornamentation,
