Each panel is composed of an arrangement of four square tiles that interlocking to form a continuous floral pattern
The design features the classic ornamental repertoire of Ottoman art, characterized by curling flowering stems, stylized floral palmettes (hatayi), and long, serrated leaves in scrolls. The color palette consists of cobalt blue and turquoise blue with highlights of brick red on a white background
