Description

Although this is a facsimile, it is indeed a relic of contact, as this nail is said to have touched an authentic nail from the Cross. It was produced by the Monastery of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem in 1877. This nail is made of forged metal, with a ribbon sealed with red wax. The nail, thus adorned with this seal, comes with its precious certificate of origin (the seals on the seal and the certificate are identical). This certificate states: To all and each of those who examine this letter, we attest and certify that this iron nail, iron, bound with a red silk ribbon and bearing our small seal, has been brought into contact with the holy Nail preserved by us, the Cistercians, in the inner chapel of the holy relics of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem; which is one of those with which Our Lord Jesus Christ was nailed to the

Cross; and that this same nail is crafted with such artistry that it appears very similar [to this one].
