The bowl is designed as a stylized flower and displays a rich ruby-pink coloration. The green uranium glass stem fluoresces vividly under ultraviolet light. A finely ribbed intermediate disc, reminiscent of a leaf or aquatic plant, enhances the organic and naturalistic design characteristic of the German
