### Description

A two-seater sofa with harmonious proportions, designed by Vico Magistretti and produced by Cassina in 1990, reflecting the enduring influence of mid-20th-century Italian design. Magistretti, one of Italy's most famous architects and designers, was renowned for his ability to reduce forms to their essence, and this piece embodies that philosophy with understated confidence. The sofa's silhouette is low, soft, and inviting, defined by Magistretti's signature blend of sculptural volumes and rigorous geometry. Generous cushions provide a sense of relaxed comfort, while the integrated armrests and slightly curved backrest give the piece an architectural and harmonious presence. It is a design that is both timeless and distinctly Italian. Upholstered in a dark, textured fabric, the sofa exhibits a slight,

uniform fading--a natural patina that develops over time and with use. The frame remains sturdy and offers good support, and the cushions retain their softness and enveloping comfort. As with all Cassina creations, the craftsmanship is impeccable: precise stitching, high-end materials, and a construction built to last. By the end of the 20th century, Cassina had established itself as a benchmark in modern design, collaborating with icons such as Le Corbusier, Charlotte Perriand, and, of course, Magistretti. This sofa, created in 1990, follows in that tradition; it represents an evolution of mid-century ideals, reinterpreted through the lens of contemporary Italian craftsmanship.
