Carved from a single block, this work highlights the interplay between the human form and the organic movements of the wood. The sculptor has skillfully utilized the natural curves, knots, and irregularities of the material to bring forth a sensual and poetic silhouette. The face, with its closed eyes and serene expression, blends harmoniously into the twisted grain of the trunk. An animal or fantastical head also appears in the upper section, reinforcing the dreamlike and symbolic nature of the composition. The sculptural work alternates between finely chiseled sections and areas left intentionally rough,
