The front features three drawers arranged in three rows, highlighted by an elegant scalloped line characteristic of Bordeaux craftsmanship. The crossbars and uprights display remarkable curved detailing, giving the piece a particularly harmonious silhouette. The piece rests on four curved legs ending in scrolls. It is topped by a thick marble slab in shades of cream and ochre, which perfectly follows the curves of the frame. The front reveals a superb grain of flamed and
