The frame features a rich decoration of scrolls, foliage, and flowers carved in high relief. The pediment is adorned with two fantastical animals facing each other--reminiscent of griffins or heraldic lions--flanking a central motif of a stylized shell. The piece as a whole showcases remarkable cabinetmaking and decorative carving. The dark brown hue highlights the relief of the ornamentation and lends this piece a particularly refined decorative presence. Its generous dimensions allow it to be placed above a fireplace as well as in an entryway, living room, or characterful
